Campbell County sprawls across the northeast corner of Wyoming, a land of rolling hills, sagebrush-covered plains and historic western towns. It lies midway between two of our country's most treasured sites: Mount Rushmore to the east and Yellowstone National Park to the west.

The county's largest communities, Gillette and Wright, are the unofficial dual "capitals" of the Powder River Basin, which lies between two of the West's most enchanting mountain ranges, the Big Horns and the Black Hills, and contains our nation's richest coal fields. Just a short drive away are Thunder Basin National Grassland and Devils Tower National Monument. This is a land of wide open spaces, brilliant blue skies and some of the friendliest people you could ever hope to meet.

- **Campbell County Recreation Center** - Pools, hot tub, sauna, field house for indoor tennis, track, soccer, and basketball, climbing tower, weight and exercise facilities and classes, racquetball, tanning beds, Kid's Zone child care, snack bar, meeting and party rooms.
- **Campbell County Library** - Meeting space for hosting 230 in Gillette and 60 in Wright.
- **Campbell County Senior Center** - Meeting space for hosting up to 300.
- **Aquatic Center** - Ten lane, 50-meter Olympic-sized pool.

If it's outdoor recreation you're after, you'll find plenty of it in Campbell County in every season of the year. Our prairies, lakes and rivers offer an abundance of opportunities: fishing, hiking, horseback riding, hunting, wildlife watching, and boating. And the mountains, just a short drive away, offer climbing, skiing, and snowmobiling. On a slightly tamer level—play a round or two of golf at one of our fine courses.

But not all the fun in Campbell County happens in the great outdoors. . . while you're here, visit our local museums, catch a performance of a stage show, or take in a concert by the Powder River Symphony. Tour and shop historic downtown Gillette, with its unique boutiques, amazing toy store, charming quilt and cheese shops, galleries, spas and fine eateries. Several other shopping centers and distinctive stores offer a wide variety of products and services in Gillette and in the town of Wright.

See the sculptures displayed throughout the community on the Avenues of the Arts. And if you're here the third week in July, don't miss the National High School Finals Rodeo - the world's largest rodeo, with contestants from 41 states, five Canadian provinces and Australia.

A Brief History Lesson – Gillette was born over a century ago, one year after Wyoming became a state. The newly built railroad opened new markets for the ranchers who grazed their cattle on the wide-open ranges of the Powder River Basin. Gillette quickly gained a reputation as the wildest cow town in Wyoming, boasting 20 saloons and a couple of churches to serve the cowboys, sheepmen, railroaders, outlaws, government regulators, and questionable characters who settled in or passed through the bustling railhead.

Trains still roll down the Burlington Northern Santa Fe tracks carrying cattle and freight to market, but now, each day they're joined by more than 65 coal trains taking 100 tons of coal per car to power plants to the south and east.

Wright, the hub of southern Campbell County, is a thriving community incorporated in 1976, spurred by the coal and oil booms that transformed Campbell County from one of the poorest counties in Wyoming to the Energy Capital of the US. Today, a new boom is underway: the production of coalbed methane gas, a clean-burning fuel encased in rich coal seams, heralding a new era of clean, green Wyoming energy.





See for Yourself – Campbell County’s open-pit mines work around-the-clock, producing more than 40 percent of the coal used to fuel America’s electric power plants. To put that figure in perspective, if this county were a country, it would be the sixth largest coal-producing nation in the world! From June through August you can experience one of our coal mines and its massive equipment right up close. Just stop by the Visitors Center in Gillette to schedule a free guided tour. Or spend as much time as you like at the coal mine overlook, or at the retired equipment display, both open year-round.
